



Culinary Arts

This TEAM EVENT is one of several **FCCLA STAR** events. Each state may submit one entry consisting of three individuals who work as a team to produce a quality meal using food service techniques and equipment. The event rules can be accessed in the National STAR Events Manual. The FCCLA Culinary Arts event is considerably different than the ProStart Competition.

The Nebraska Team will be named as a result of their performance during the Nebraska ProStart Student Invitational Team competition.

WHO QUALIFIES:

1. Participation is open to any nationally affiliated FCCLA **occupational** member.
2. Participants must be or have been enrolled in a food service occupational training program.
3. It is preferable that the Nebraska team be composed of members from the same chapter. However, if one team member cannot attend the National Meeting, the substitute may be a member of another Nebraska chapter. Distance between chapters will be a consideration as it would be advantageous for the team to practice together between the time they qualify and the national competition. The FCCLA Culinary Arts event is structured quite differently from the ProStart event.

HOW TO BE CONSIDERED AS NEBRASKA'S REPRESENTATIVE TO THE NATIONAL EVENT:

Complete and return the form at bottom of page. Each team member must be nationally affiliated as an FCCLA **occupational** member; affiliation will be checked by state FCCLA office prior to March 1.

HOW REPRESENTATIVE WILL BE DETERMINED:

1. Teams meeting eligibility requirements will be posted at the ProStart Invitational.
2. The highest ranked eligible team during the Nebraska ProStart Team Competition will be named as Nebraska's representative to the National STAR Culinary Arts event.
