



New Chapter Grant

The purpose of this program is to promote the development of new Family, Career and Community Leaders of America Chapters in Nebraska. The Nebraska FCCLA New Chapter grant will provide up to \$500 in cash and resources toward starting an FCCLA chapter.

This grant will be awarded based on the completion of the following criteria:

- a) Submit a completed application, which must include signatures of an administrator, adviser, and student leader, prior to October 1.
- b) Have not had an affiliated chapter in the last five (5) years.
- c) Affiliate at least twelve (12) members and one (1) adviser at the national level prior to December 1 for two (2) consecutive years.
- d) Attend District Planning Meetings and District Leadership Conference and at least one of the following conferences: Fall Leadership Workshop, Peer Education Conference, State Leadership Conference or assist with the District STAR Event Competition for two (2) years with at least one (1) student and one (1) adviser present at each.
- e) Present to the local school board about their participation in FCCLA.
- f) Submit an application for a Nebraska Chapter Award and a Nebraska National Programs Award each year

In return, the State Association agrees to the following:

- a) Reimburse National and State dues for twelve (12) students and one (1) adviser by December 31 totaling a payment of up to \$169, during the first year.
- b) Provide the chapter with one (1) National Programs program guide (virtual edition) of their choosing each of the two years, upon affiliation, and an FCCLA gavel.
- c) Provide support in the form of the State Adviser, State Officer Team, or other individuals deemed necessary by the goals of the chapter.
- d) Provide an additional \$100 stipend to the chapter treasury by May 15 upon successful completion of the two (2) year agreement.

Leadership Development

Leadership development is more than just part of the mission for Nebraska FCCLA. It is a large part decision making that we go through when considering events, conferences, programming, and more. With a tagline of "The Ultimate Leadership Experience," Nebraska FCCLA believes in building the leadership skills and experiences of its members.

At every FCCLA conference, leadership development takes center stage. Whether it is preparing a student for their role as a chapter officer at Fall Leadership Workshop or connecting students to unique program training at State Leadership Conference, we work to provide diverse growth opportunities for every student. In addition, all conferences sponsored by Nebraska FCCLA have been cross walked to the Nebraska Career Readiness Standards which identifies what skills a student will gain be attending that event.

Leadership Roles

Students can also practice their leadership skills through a variety of leadership roles in FCCLA. This could include leading a committee at the local level or running for a position on the National Executive Council. Through these experiences students are tested and stretched to new levels while taking an active role in improving their family, school and community.
